Dear Mr. DeRouen,

I hereby notify the Public Service Commission that we are opposed to the announced intentions of AmeriGas to discontinue our current central gas service in Old Bridge Subdivision, Danville, KY and replace it with individual residential tanks.

We have lived in our house with propane gas heat from the main tank for over 20 years and want to continue with it the same way.

The following points should be considered:

- 1) We have all paid significant tap on fees (\$500-1000) to receive the current gas supply.
- 2) The Old Bridge Subdivision area has building restrictions. One of the restrictions states no personal tanks are allowed. It would violate the very rules we have had to abide by since the late 1980's.
- 3) One of our neighbors, Jim Porter, explained the extreme cost increase we would incur if we go to individual tanks. Such cost increases could adversely affect home resale values.


The proposed changes should not be allowed.

The most important statement is we should not be penalized with increasing gas prices for the benefit of the parent company.
