APPLICATION

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), pursuant to KRS 278.018(6) and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8, hereby applies for approval of changes in certified service territory as agreed with Blue Grass Energy ("Blue Grass").

- 1. <u>Address</u>: The Applicant's full name and post office address is Kentucky Utilities Company, One Quality Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507.
- 2. <u>Articles of Incorporation</u>: A certified copy of Kentucky Utilities Company's Restated Articles of Incorporation is on file with the Commission in Case No. 2010-00204.
- 3. <u>Statement of Business</u>: KU is a public utility engaged in the business of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric service.
- 4. <u>Description of Changes in Service Territory</u>: KU and Blue Grass have individually agreed to the requested territorial change.

The territorial boundary change requested involves 1 parcel of land that includes the property of Kendra Curtis in Wilmore, Kentucky. This requested change will serve the purposes of KRS 278.016 by avoiding the unnecessary encumbering of the landscape and minimizing disputes between retail electric suppliers. It is also necessary for the public convenience and necessity. The territorial maps and attachments provided constitute the entire agreement between KU and Blue Grass.

5. Agreement and Maps: Attached as Application Exhibit 1 of this filing includes the summary list identifying KU and Blue Grass personnel familiar with the specifics of the facilities available, the reason for the change and purposes served under KRS 278.016, and copies of the territorial (quadrant) map, detail map, and agreement signed by both parties for the

property involved.

WHEREFORE, KU hereby requests, pursuant to KRS 278.018, that the Commission enter its order approving the service territory changes and Agreements allocating these electric consumers as agreed to by the parties. Due to the bulk of the maps, KU requests the Commission to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001 Section 7(1) and permit KU to file only two complete set of maps.
