In reference to the Legal Notice of November 16, 2014 for Peaks Mill Water District the below listed customers would like to object to the price increase the water district listed.

First of all, Peaks Mill Water District received at least two (2) price increases in 2013.

Secondly, we have the highest water bills in Franklin County. We do not understand why the water district has to have at least ten (10) dollars more for 2,000 gallons a month then other water districts. Farmdale's water is less than \$17 a month with the school tax added; North Shelby Water District is asking for a price increase, which if granted will make their 2,000 gallons only \$17.96 without the school tax. It really is odd that we will have to pay \$27 a month for 2,000 gallon without the additional school tax and other water districts pay much less. Plus, Peaks Mill Water District wants an additional \$3.044 for the next 1,000 gallon.

As consumers we know everything is rising except pay but there needs to be an end to the rising cost of water for the Peaks Mill Water District. Therefore, we hope that the Public Service Commission does NOT grant this latest request for a price increase or any other price increase until every other water district is paying at least close to what we pay.
