ORDER

On August 13, 2014, the Commission issued an Order in Case No. 2014-00230 initiating a proceeding to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") of Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") for the six-month period that ended on April 30, 2014. On February 5, 2015, the Commission issued an Order in Case No. 2014-00455 initiating a proceeding to review Big Rivers' FAC for the two-year period from November 1, 2012, through October 31, 2014, and establishing a procedural schedule for this review. On February 19, 2015, the Commission issued an Order consolidating the two proceedings and stated that all parties to Case No. 2014-00230 were deemed to be parties to Case No. 2014-00455. Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") is a party to Case No. 2014-00230 and, therefore, is deemed to be a party to Case No. 2014-00455.

On March 2, 2015, KIUC filed a motion requesting that the procedural schedule be amended by establishing a deadline of April 3, 2015, for intervenor testimony, which

is two weeks after Big Rivers' responses to interrogatories are due. KIUC also requested that all other current procedural deadlines be shifted by an equivalent number of days. KIUC states that permitting intervenors an opportunity to file testimony would result in the development of a more comprehensive record and assist the Commission in addressing the issues to be raised in this matter.

Having reviewed the evidence and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that KIUC has presented good cause to amend the procedural schedule to allow for the filing of intervenor testimony. The Commission will also amend the procedural schedule to allow for discovery on intervenor testimony and the filing of rebuttal testimony by Big Rivers. The inclusion of additional steps in the procedural schedule will require the rescheduling of the hearing in this matter, which had been set for April 7, 2015. Therefore, the Commission finds that all parties should adhere to the procedural schedule attached as an appendix to this Order.

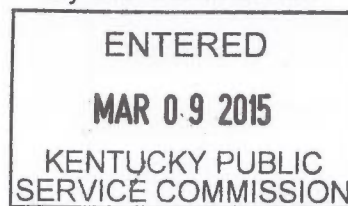
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
