ORDER

On February 4, 2014, Ledbetter Water District ("Ledbetter") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- Ledbetter purchases water from Crittenden-Livingston Water District ("Crittenden-Livingston").
- 2. On March 1, 2014, Crittenden-Livingston increased its wholesale rate to Ledbetter from \$2.34 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.46 per 1,000 gallons.²
- 3. Ledbetter proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective February 25, 2014. Since Crittenden-Livingston did not increase its wholesale rate to Ledbetter until March 1, 2014, Ledbetter cannot increase its rates prior to this date.
- 4. During the 12 months ending December 31, 2013, Ledbetter purchased 37,001,010 gallons of water from Crittenden-Livingston, and produced 48,302,700 gallons of water. It sold 59,678,643 gallons of water during the same period.

- 5. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$4,440.12, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons.
- 6. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 7. Ledbetter's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B, are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
- 2. Ledbetter's proposed effective date of February 25, 2014, is denied.
- 3. Ledbetter's proposed rates are approved for water service rendered on or after March 1, 2014.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Ledbetter shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
