By letter dated March 14, 2014, we were notified by our wholesale supplier, Owensboro Municipal Utilities (OMU) will be increasing their rate charged to us from \$ 1.60 per 1,000 gallons to \$ 1.64 per 1,000 gallons effective June 1, 2014. As a result, we are submitting a purchased water rate adjustment (PWA) for the increased water cost to the West Daviess County Water District.
