ORDER

On December 15, 2014, the Commission issued an Order suspending the procedural schedule established in the November 14, 2014 Order in this Case. The Commission suspended the procedural schedule because information provided by the city of Danville ("Danville") did not clearly indicate whether Danville's proposed rates were based on a forecasted test period or a historical test period. Commission Staff held an informal conference on December 18, 2014, with Danville, Garrard County Water Association, Inc., and Parksville Water District.¹

During the informal conference, Danville clarified that it is seeking an adjustment in its wholesale rate based on a historical test period. Danville agreed to provide information tracing the pro forma adjustments to the cost-of-service study no later than January 5, 2015. At the end of the informal conference, the parties of record agreed to a revised procedural schedule.

Based on the parties' agreement to a revised procedural schedule, the Commission, on its own motion, finds that the procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order should be followed.
