 Within 15 days of the date of this Order, Danville shall file its tariff setting forth the rates it is placing in effect and designating those rates as being subject to change and refund.

2. Danville shall maintain its records in such manner as will allow it, the Commission, or any customer to determine the amounts to be refunded and to whom in the event a refund is ordered upon final resolution of this matter.
