ORDER

On January 6, 2015, Licking Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Licking Valley”) petitioned the Commission for approval of a permanent on-bill financing program and included tariff sheets for such a program. On January 14, 2015, the Commission suspended the proposed tariff. A request for information was issued to Licking Valley on January 23, 2015, with directions that a response be filed within 14 days.

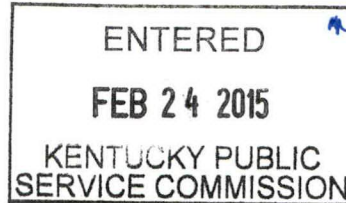
Thereafter, on February 19, 2015, Licking Valley moved the Commission for an extension of time until March 9, 2015, in which to file its responses to the request for information. In support, Licking Valley states the extension is needed to obtain help in responding to the information requests from the staff of the Mountain Association for Community Economic Development (“MACED”). Licking Valley states that it has a meeting scheduled with MACED on February 26, 2015.

The Commission, having considered Licking Valley’s motion, finds that good cause exists to grant an extension of time up to and including March 9, 2015, in which to respond to the request for information.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
