COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO WESTERN LEWIS-RECTORVILLE WATER AND GAS DISTRICT

Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and ten copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before March 22, 2017. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Western Lewis shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which

Western Lewis fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When filing a paper containing personal information, Western Lewis shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide a schedule showing Western Lewis's purchases and sales volumes in Mcf for the most current 24-month period available. The schedule should be provided in Excel format.

2. Explain whether Western Lewis has considered the possibility of using the Refund Adjustment ("RA") component of its Gas Cost Adjustment mechanism to refund the amounts due to customers from prior over-collections of gas costs, and setting all quarterly Actual Adjustments ("AA") and Balance Adjustments ("BA") to \$0. For example, Western Lewis's remaining over/under-collections originally calculated to be reconciled through the AA and BA could be combined into one 24-month RA factor, and all the quarterly AA and BA factors could then be set to \$0. If approved by the Commission, Western Lewis's AA and BA could then be used to begin reconciling only more recent under/over-recoveries of gas cost resulting from estimated versus actual cost of gas.
