

Due to a rate increase from the Morehead Utility Plant Board, please accept this as formal notice that the Bath County Water District has filed an Application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates. The new proposed wholesale rate will be \$3.38 per 1,000 gallons purchased. This proposed change will be effective for all service rendered on and after February 15, 2016.





The Sharpsburg Water District board of commissioners met at the water office in regular session at 7:00 pm. Members present: Roger Wills, Randy Warner, Judy Harmon, and Alfred Bailey. Also present, George, Ricky, Gayle, and Michael Purvis.

The meeting was called to order. Last months' minutes were read. Randy made a motion to approve minutes, Alfred seconded. All in favor.

Michael Purvis was in attendance because of a high water bill. Since we purchase all of our water, the policy of the board does not allow for any adjustments. If the water went through the meter, the customer has to pay for it. Michael will set up payments to pay this bill.

Ricky requested a pay increase. Randy made a motion to increase his salary \$100.00 per 2 week pay period, and also to check into getting him health insurance through the District's group plan. Judy seconded. All in favor. Pay increase will be effective on the next pay period of Feb. 25th.


In other business, there was discussion on retaining Damon Tally as our attorney to represent the District in matters regarding the 911 fee in Nicholas County. This was tabled until the April meeting.

Judy made a motion to approve .07 per 1,000 gallons water purchase adjustment from Bath County Water District (supplier). Alfred seconded. All in favor. The effective date will be water purchased after Feb, 15, 2016.

The board went into executive session to discuss personnel matters.
