ORDER

On April 4, 2016, Christian County Water District ("Christian County") applied to the Commission for approval to enter into an amended assistance agreement with the Kentucky Rural Water Finance Corporation ("KRWFC") to issue securities in the approximate principal amount of \$2,315,000 for the purpose of re-amortizing a certain outstanding loan. After filing deficiencies were cured, Christian County's application was accepted for filing by the Commission on April 12, 2016.

Having considered the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Christian County proposes to execute an amended assistance agreement with KRWFC to borrow \$2,315,000 subject to an adjustment of up to 10 percent. The proposed loan will have a 15-year term subject to interest rates that range from 2.45 percent to 3.30 percent.¹

- 2. Christian County proposes to use the proceeds from the assistance agreement to re-amortize the outstanding KRWFC Public Projects Refunding Revenue Bonds (Flexible Term Program) Series 2005C.²
- 3. Christian County estimates that its proposed refinancing will result in total gross savings and net present value savings of \$179,718 and \$145,310, respectively.³
- Christian County will expend \$2,401,872 to refund the outstanding bonds and to pay bond issuance costs.⁴
- 5. Christian County's proposed loan is for a lawful object within its corporate purposes, is reasonably necessary and appropriate for and consistent with the proper performance of its service to the public, will not impair Christian County's ability to perform that service, and is reasonably necessary and appropriate for such purpose.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Christian County is authorized to enter into an agreement with KRWFC to borrow no more than \$2,546,500⁵ for the purpose of re-amortizing the outstanding indebtedness, but only under such terms and conditions that will produce both positive gross savings and net present value savings.
- 2. If the actual terms and conditions of the agreement with KRWFC differ from those set forth in its application, Christian County shall, within 30 days of executing

the loan agreement, file with the Commission amortization schedules and work papers showing the actual gross savings and net present value savings that will result from the refinancing.

- 3. Within 30 days of executing the proposed agreement, Christian County shall file a copy of the executed Assistance Agreement and any documents referenced in the executed Assistance Agreement that Christian County has not previously filed with the Commission.
- 4. The proceeds from the Assistance Agreement shall be used only for the lawful purposes specified in Christian County's application.
- Any documents filed pursuant to ordering paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Order shall reference the number of this case and shall be retained in the utility's general correspondence file.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding of value for any purpose or as a warranty on the part of the Commonwealth of Kentucky or any agency thereof as to the securities authorized herein.
