Bullitt Utilities, Inc. ("Bullitt Utilities") expects to file an Application with the Public Service Commission ("PSC") on November 30, 2016 to establish a surcharge in the amount of \$17.00 to recover the extraordinary emergency costs incurred from the failure of the Hunters Hollow Wastewater Treatment Plan on March 29, 2014. The PSC has assigned Bullitt Utilities' Application Case No. 2016-00401. The proposed charges shown below have a proposed effective date of January 1, 2017.

A Residential Equivalent is defined as the customer's average monthly consumption in gallons divided by 12,000 gallons.

Any person may also examine this filing at the PSC located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday – Friday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm or on the PSC website at <http://psc.ky.gov>, telephone (502) 564-3940.

Any person may submit comments regarding this filing by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602; or through its website at <http://psc.ky.gov>.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Bullitt Utilities but the PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing.
