ORDER

On November 30, 2017, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. (“Columbia”) filed an application to extend its Gas Cost Adjustment Performance-Based Rate (“PBR”) mechanism for an additional five years, from March 31, 2018, through March 31, 2023.¹ The Commission finds that Columbia’s current PBR, with no change to any aspect of its calculation, should be approved for continued use pending a final Order in this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Columbia shall continue to use its current PBR mechanism until the Commission issues a Final Order addressing Columbia’s request for a five-year extension of its PBR in the pending case.
