
Also, it should be noted that the bulk loading rate of \$9.00 per 1000 gallons will remain the same.



Due to a rate increase from the Morehead Utility Plant Board, please accept this as formal notice that the Bath County Water District has filed an Application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates. The new proposed wholesale rate will be \$3.55 per 1,000 gallons purchased. This proposed change will be effective for all service rendered on and after February 15, 2017.

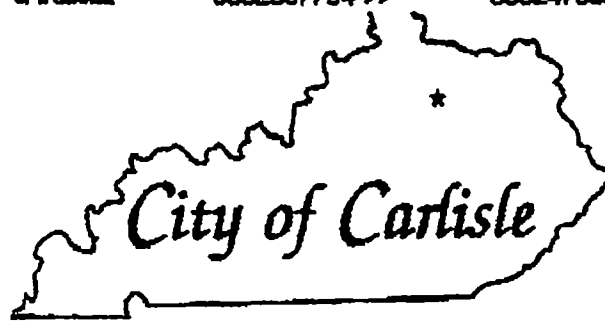
