

The initial rate adjustment was made pursuant to the date of an order granting an increase in rates. North McLean's application and records, the PSC Staff has recommended its rates to their retail customers that are different from those proposed reflect the present retail rates and the retail rates proposed by the PSC Staff.

**APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT ACROSS OR ALONG A STREAM
AND / OR WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION**

Chapter 151 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes requires approval from the Division of Water prior to any construction or other activity in or along a stream that could in any way obstruct flood flows or adversely impact water quality. If the project involves work in a stream, such as bank stabilization, dredging or relocation, you will also need to obtain 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) from the Division of Water. This completed form will be forwarded to the Water Quality Branch for WQC processing. The project may not start until all necessary approvals are received from the KDOW. For questions concerning the WQC process, contact the WQC section at 502-564-3410.

If the project will disturb one more acres of land, or if the project is part of a larger common plan of development or sale that ultimately will disturb one or more acres, you will also need to complete a Notice of Intent for general permit coverage for storm water discharges associated with construction activities (NOI-SWCA). The general permit will require you to create and implement an erosion control plan for the project. You may find the forms for Kentucky Pollution Discharge Elimination System (KPDES) at the KPDES Web site http://www.water.ky.gov/homepage_repository/kpdes_permit_apls.htm. On June 26, 2017, North McLean County Water District ("North McLean") applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") for authority to adjust its rates for water service. The initial proposed effective date of the requested rate adjustment was made pursuant to the date of an order granting an increase by the PSC. After performing a limited review of North McLean's application and records, the PSC Staff has recommended to the PSC that North McLean adjust its rates to their retail customers that are different from those proposed by North McLean. The tables below reflect the present retail rates and the retail rates proposed by the PSC Staff:
