


**MOTION TO RESCHEDULE HEARING**

Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC, (Frontier) by counsel, moves to reschedule the hearing set for November 21, 2017. Frontier's Managing Member and primary witness, Steve Shute, lives in Glenwood Springs, CO. He will be out of the country from November 7 until Sunday November, 19 after a return trip of 25 hours arriving in Denver at 4:00 p.m. mst. His travel will prevent preparation for the hearing and the timing of his return will make a trip to Kentucky problematic, particularly with the Thanksgiving holiday on the following Thursday. There is no other witness that can substitute for Mr. Shute.

Because of the need for Mr. Shute's presence at the hearing and the conflict with his schedule, Frontier requests the hearing be rescheduled to November 28 or 29 of the following week. The Attorney General is the only intervenor and has no objection to either date.
