Question 1A: The total purchases are the 45129 which includes the volume that (MAGO) used 1489. I never changed the purchase volume from last EGC.

Question 1B: conversion factor 1.03045

Question 1C: In 2016 I was including the Industrial use customer. I do not get a separate bill from Constellation for my Industrial Customer – they buy the same gas that my residential and commercial customers use. The Industrial customer used a lot more in 2016 than this year.
