The maximum income of both of these food distributions is currently about \$1200.00 per individual per month. The majority of these individuals live on \$750.00 per month. Out of the individuals that live on \$750.00 per month also have to pay their expenses like rent, electricity, gas, phone and water. The \$750.00 must also cover food, medical care and transportation. They must also buy water to drink and to cook with. The 49% increase to the water rates proposed by the Martin County Water District will add another burden on to the low income citizens of Martin County.
