I have enclosed copies of two letters sent to the Martin County Water District — one addressed to Joe Hammond/Linda Sumpter dated Feb. 2, 2018 and the other for today to Brian Cumbo, counsel for MCWD and they are in reference to PSC Case No. 2018-00017.

The letters are self-explanatory. This is in protest of any rate increase for the water district if they are unresponsive to letters of requests that I, as editor of this newspaper, have made. Plus, while I realize the new water district board has been given a chance to "fix it" (the problems of past refusals to address PSC orders following investigations), I see no change in the way this board is operating so far from past boards — refusals to honor open records request and refusing outright to even field questions in open, public meetings, from local media or customers.

So much for the "transparency" the new board promised, along with working with local media!

In closing if I find what I believe I will find when my open records request is

finally honored, I firmly believe that MCWD chairman John Horn is complicit in an obvious coverup.

Thank you for considering this as part of this process. My opinion is that customers would be better solved if the district was considered abandoned and placed into receivership. This board overall is no different than past boards.
