ORDER

On July 20, 2018, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) filed its answer to the complaint of Margaret Beaumont-Carver (Complainant) as required pursuant to the Commission's Order of July 10, 2018. LG&E also moved the Commission to dismiss the complaint upon a claim that Complainant's requested relief is barred under the doctrine of *res judicata*. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5(2), provides that a response to a motion shall be filed within seven days from the date of the filing of the motion unless the Commission orders otherwise. To date, Complainant has not filed a response addressing LG&E's motion to dismiss. Because Complainant is proceeding *pro se*, the Commission will allow Complainant a reasonable extension of time in which to submit a response.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
