

Miller was arrested and By 1:30 p.m., Knox Coun-ty Sheriff Mike Smith and Deputies Mullins, Hudson substance (Methamphetamine), first-degree traf-ficking in controlled substance, trafficking in mar-IJuana, possession of drug paraphernalia and posses-sion of handgun by convicted felon.

This arrest came after a Federal Court.

2017, when Deputy Mullins located and setzed approximately a half pound of Crystal Methamphetamine during a search at the same residence. Miller was arrested and charged with first-degree trafficking in controlled substance (Methamphetamine) and carrying concealed deadly lins and Claude Hudson done, Hydrocodone, Neurontin and Subutex), a Knox County Detention weapon at that time. These charges are still pending in




