



REQUEST NO. 1: State whether Edmonson is Transferring its entire sewage treatment operation to Caveland. If not, will Edmonson continue as an operator of a sewage treatment to be transferred.

RESPONSE: The Edmonson County Water District is transferring only the sewer system east of the Green River. The Edmonson County Water District is keeping and will continue to operate the sewer system west of the Green River which is located within the city limits of Brownsville. The Edmonson County Water District currently operators two (2) individual sewer systems only and does not treat sewage. The system that is being proposed to be transferred is treated by Caveland Sanitation Authority, Inc. and the system that the Edmonson County Water District is keeping and will continue to operate is treated by the City of Brownsville. Said statement is reflected in the Affidavit of Tony Sanders and is labeled as "Exhibit A" and attached hereto and made a part hereof.

REQUEST NO. 2: State how many customers are currently served by the sewer system that is proposed to be transferred.

Comes the Affiant, TONY SANDERS, and after being duly sworn, deposes and states as follows, to-wit:


1. My name is TONY SANDERS, and I am the General Manager for Edmonson County Water District.


