This letter is in response to your correspondence dated May 21, 2018. You have expressed concerns that the cellular tower proposed by East Kentucky Network, LLC d/b/a Appalachian Wireless (“EKN”) may encroach upon your adjoining property. While it is not within the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission (“PSC”) to settle property disputes and is not the appropriate venue in which to adjudicate such matters, EKN does not believe an encroachment issue exists.

Prior to filing the referenced application with the PSC, the site was surveyed by a Licensed Professional Land Surveyor. The surveyor was consulted again regarding his survey after receipt of your letter. EKN remains confident that neither existing structures nor any proposed structures, including the tower, equipment building, and fencing, encroach or will encroach upon your property.
