- 4. If any document requested herein was at one time in existence, but has been lost, discarded or destroyed, identify such document as completely as possible, including the type of document, its date, the date or approximate date it was lost, discarded or destroyed, the identity of the person (s) who last had possession of the document and the identity of all persons having knowledge of the contents thereof.

These interrogatories are continuing in nature, and information which the responding party later becomes aware of, or has access to, and which is responsive to any request is to be made available to Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers. Any studies, documents, or other subject matter not yet completed that will be relied upon during the course of this case should be so identified and provided as soon as they are completed. The Respondent is obliged to change, supplement and correct all answers to interrogatories to conform to available information, including such information as it first becomes available to the Respondent after the answers hereto are served.
- 3. Unless otherwise expressly provided, each interrogatory should be construed independently and not with reference to any other interrogatory herein for purpose of limitation.
- 4. The answers provided should first restate the question asked and also identify the person(s) supplying the information.
- 5. Please answer each designated part of each information request separately. If you do not have complete information with respect to any interrogatory, so state and give as much information as you do have with respect to the matter inquired about, and identify each person whom you believe may have additional information with respect thereto.

- Q.1-1. Provide a copy of each Station Two purchased power contract cited in the Application in this proceeding.
- Q.1-2. Provide a copy of each Station Two service contract related to Big Rivers' operation of Station Two cited in the Application in this proceeding.
- Q.1-3. Provide all memos and other documents provided to the Big Rivers' Board of Directors regarding the establishment of an \$89.6 million regulatory asset associated with the termination of the Station Two purchased power contracts cited in the Application in this proceeding versus a write-off of the \$89.6 million.
- Q.1-4. Provide all studies or other analysis prepared by Big Rivers or on its behalf regarding the financial implications of writing off the \$89.6 million associated with the termination of the Station Two purchased power contracts in lieu of establishing a regulatory asset.
- Q.1-5. Provide all memos and other documents provided to the Big Rivers' Board of Directors regarding the expiration and/or termination of the Station Two contracts.
- Q.1-6. Provide Big Rivers most recent long term financial forecast and financial model in live Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas intact.
- Q.1-7. Provide Big Rivers most recent Board policy regarding the appropriate level of member equity.
- Q.1-8. Provide the calculation of Big Rivers minimum equity level under each of its loan agreements at December 31, 2017 and at the end of each month thereafter for which actual information is available. Cite to the specific relevant provisions of each loan agreement.
