

Madison County Utilities District**



Richmond Utilities is providing notice that on May 1, 2018, it filed with the Public Service Commission to increase the wholesale rate and Kentucky River Authority Fee it charges Kirksville Water Association and Madison County Utility District effective for water service on and after July 1, 2018. The proposed rates are as follows:

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing.

Notice is hereby given that Madison County Utilities District has filed an application with the Public Service Commission ("PSC") to adjust its water rates as a result of an increase from its supplier, Richmond Utilities. The proposed effective date is July 1, 2018. The proposed changes are as follows:
