NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC OF UTILITY RATE CHANGE

Peaks Mill Water District

Due to an increase from its supplier, Peaks Mill Water District ("Peaks Mill") has asked for approval from the Public Service Commission to adjust its rates for water service rendered on and after July 20, 2018.

The monthly bill for an average customer using 5,000 gallons of water each month will increase \$0.60 (or 1.0%) from \$55.27 to \$55.87.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Peaks Mill Water District as follows:


SECTION 1. That the District hereby accepts the rate awarded by the Public Service Commission and approves the raising of rates by a like amount to its customers.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.



If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of initial publication or mailing of the notice, the Commission may take final action on the rate schedule.
