The Kentucky River Authority ("KRA") has notified the City of Lawrenceburg ("Lawrenceburg") that it is increasing the rate of the Tier II withdrawal fee effective July 1, 2018. In order to pass along the increased fee, Lawrenceburg plans to file with the Public Service Commission, no later than August 1, 2018, a proposed rate schedule, to be effective September 1, 2018, that will increase the KRA Fee charged to South Anderson Water District as follows:

Dear Mr. Cook:

As you know, FPB withdraws water from the Kentucky River that is used to supply our customers. Recently, the Kentucky River Authority increased its withdrawal fee. This fee is a "pass through". That is, FPB remits these funds to the Kentucky River Authority. Nevertheless, FPB is required to file a new tariff for this fee with the Public Service Commission.

Enclosed is a filing notice and a new tariff that FPB filed with the Public Service Commission on June 26, 2018 reflecting an increase in the Kentucky River Authority withdrawal fee. The Kentucky River Authority increased its Tier II water use fee by 9 cents from 13.0 cents to 22 cents per 1,000 gallons. We expect the new rate to be effective July 26, 2018.

Based on South Anderson's average monthly usage, the proposed increase of 9 cents per 1,000 gallons will be approximately \$835.66 per month



The Kentucky River Authority, at its April 9th board meeting, voted to adjust the Tier II water withdrawal fee set forth in administrative regulation 420 KAR 1:050. Beginning July 1, 2018 the new Tier II rate will be \$0.22 per 1,000 gallons of water withdrawn. (Currently this rate is \$0.13 per 1,000 gallons). The Tier I rate will remain unchanged. This rate increase is necessary to fund the debt service required for the capital improvements at Dam 10 on the Kentucky River. If you have any questions, please call our office at (502) 564-2866.

PUBLIC NOTICE SOUTH ANDERSON WATER DISTRICT PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT

Due to increases in the wholesale rate for water purchased from the City of Lawrenceburg and Frankfort Plant Board, the South Anderson Water District has applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for a rate increase to cover its increased costs. The rates contained herein are the rates proposed by South Anderson Water District for all customers, however the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that are higher or lower than the rates proposed in this notice. Any corporation, association, body public or person may request leave to intervene by motion within thirty (30) days after notice of the proposed rates change is given. A motion to intervene shall be in writing, shall be submitted to the Executive Director, Kentucky Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P. O. Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the motion including the status and interest of the party. The application may be reviewed at the South Anderson Water District at 142 South Main St., Lawrenceburg, KY 40342 and the Kentucky Public Service Commission office listed above Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the Commission's website at <http://psc.ky.gov>.

The proposed rates are scheduled to go into effect with the October 2018 meter readings which will be reflected on the first billing following November 1, 2018. The proposed rate increase of \$0.11/1,000 gallons or 1.11% on the average monthly bill will compensate for the higher wholesale purchase water rates allowed the Frankfort Plant Board and City of Lawrenceburg by the Public Service Commission.

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH ANDERSON WATER DISTRICT, AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW RATES, SUBMITTING NEW RATES TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING A REPRESENTATIVE TO SIGN ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Frankfort Plant Board and City of Lawrenceburg are raising the wholesale cost of water due an increase in the water withdrawal fee charged them by the Kentucky River Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Commission has approved the resulting rate increase requested by the Frankfort Plant Board and is anticipated to do the same for the rate increase requested by the City of Lawrenceburg; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to adjust its rates to its customers to reflect the wholesale rate increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the South Anderson Water District as follows:

SECTION 1. That the District hereby accepts the rate increases of its wholesale suppliers and approves the raising of rates by a compensating amount to its customers.

SECTION 2. That the Chair is hereby authorized, directed and empowered by the District's Board of Commissioners to execute the necessary documents, and to otherwise act on behalf of the District to implement the changed rates.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
