

The Kentucky River Authority, at its April 9th board meeting, voted to adjust the Tier II water withdrawal fee set forth in administrative regulation 420 KAR 1:050. **Beginning July 1, 2018 the new Tier II rate will be \$0.22 per 1,000 gallons** of water withdrawn. (Currently this rate is \$0.13 per 1,000 gallons). The Tier I rate will remain unchanged. This rate increase is necessary to fund the debt service required for the capital improvements at Dam 10 on the Kentucky River. If you have any questions, please call our office at (502) 564-2866.



SOUTH WOODFORD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT RESOLUTION REGARDING PURCHASED WATER RATE ADJUSTMENT

WHEREAS, the South Woodford County Water District (the Water District) has been notified by its water supplier, the City of Versailles, that the Kentucky River Authority has increased the water withdrawal fee for water withdrawn from the Kentucky River and that the City of Versailles has therefore increased it fees charged to the Water District; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Water District to adjust the rates it charges to its customers in order pay for the increased cost of the water purchased by the Water District from the City of Versailles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SOUTH WOODFORD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the rates charged by the Water District to its customers shall be adjusted as follows:

Section 2. That the Chairman of the Water District is authorized to sign and submit an application to the Commonwealth of Kentucky Public Service Commission setting forth the foregoing adjustment to the Water District's rates.

Section 3. The adjustment in the Water District's rates shall be effective August 1, 2018.

The forgoing Resolution was passed by the unanimous vote of the Commissioners of the South Woodford County Water District at a properly called special meeting held on the 20^{th} day of August, 2018.
