Greetings,

This email is in regards to case number 2018-00295.

LG&E does not need to increase by 12.2%. They passed a bill last year to stop giving discounts to households with their own solar panels. They just got an increase in 2017. "With the PSC's changes, a typical LG&E residential electric bill will increase by about \$6.42 per month. The monthly bill for a typical KU residential customer will increase by about \$3.85.

LG&E residential natural gas customers will see an increase of about \$6.98 per month in base rate charges, although a portion of that will be offset by a reduction of nearly \$5 per month in a surcharge that pays for gas line safety improvements. The base rates do not include the cost of the gas itself, which accounts for about half the total bill." 2017
