ORDER

Pursuant to the Commission's May 28, 2019 Order, a formal conference with all parties was held on Tuesday, June 11, 2019, in order for the Commission to explain the procedure to be followed during the hearings. The attorneys in attendance in person and by telephone had the opportunity to request clarification on procedure and notify the Commission of any pending issues to be resolved. Morgan County Water District notified the Commission of a scheduling conflict and proposed to contact Commission Staff and other parties to resolve the matter by switching hearing dates with another party. The parties contacted Commission Staff to explain the scheduling conflict could be resolved by Morgan County Water District switching hearing date and time with Hyden-Leslie County Water District and that both parties agreed to the change. Further, Milburn Water District's attorney alerted the Commission of a potential conflict; however, when Commission Staff followed-up with him, the matter had already been resolved internally.

The Commission explained that the issues to be addressed at the hearings will generally be those addressed in data requests, including, but not limited to, sufficiency of the current rate structure, capital improvement plan status, outstanding debt, management and operations, depreciation, and age of service lines and meters. On July

1, 2019 Staff will issue a list of required witnesses to appear and requested documents to be produced at the hearings.

The Commission HEREBY ORDERS that the following hearings in this matter shall be rescheduled and held as follows:

1. With Morgan County Water District on Tuesday, July 9, 2019, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 at the offices of the Public Service Commission.

2. With Hyden-Leslie County Water District on Tuesday, July 16, 2019, at 1 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 2 at the offices of the Public Service Commission.

3. All other provisions of the Commission's May 28, 2019 Order shall remain in full force and effect.

4. No later than July 1, 2019, Commission Staff shall file with the Commission and serve upon the parties of record a list of witnesses to appear at the hearings and a list of documents to be produced by the parties at the hearings.
