ORDER

On February 28, 2019, Louisville Gas & Electric Company (LG&E) and Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) (jointly, LG&E/KU) filed, through the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revisions to its annual electric Demand Side Management (DSM) Balancing Adjustment (DBA).¹ In addition, LG&E/KU proposed revisions to the DSM Capital Cost Recovery Component (DCCR) for the Residential Service and General Service rate customers due to the Commission increasing the number of customers authorized to participate in LG&E's Advanced Metering Systems Customer Service Offering.

The proposed tariffs contain an effective date of April 1, 2019. KRS 278.180(1) asserts that no change shall be made by any utility in any rate except upon 30 days' notice to the Commission. Having reviewed the tariffs and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of LG&E/KU's proposed Electric tariffs to revise the DBA and DCCR and that such an investigation cannot be completed by April 1, 2019. Therefore, pursuant to

KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed Electric tariffs for one day and allow them to become effective on April 2, 2019, subject to change prospectively.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. LG&E/KU's proposed Electric tariffs to revise the DBA and DCCR are suspended for one day, and shall become effective April 2, 2019, subject to change prospectively.

2. The electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, shall be used in the processing of this matter.

3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, LG&E/KU shall, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, file their revised tariffs reflecting that they are allowed to become effective April 2, 2019, subject to change prospectively, pursuant to this Order.

4. Requests for intervention shall be filed no later than April 15, 2019. Any party who submits a motion to intervene after April 15, 2019, and upon a showing of good cause is granted full intervention, shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule, if any.
