What are those bugs in my food?

You open a bag of whole wheat flour and find some webs. Ew! Here's how to deal with them.

#### WHAT ARE PANTRY MOTH?

You've just encountered them. They can infest bags or boxes of whole wheat flour, dried fruit, dog food, bird seed, fruits, and/or seedheads. One Cooperative Extension report states that infestation of products occurs when the insects are present in food products."

Not a very appetizing image, but it's a pantry moth.

#### WHERE DO PANTRY MOTH?

Although you may need to clean up after housekeeping. Meal moths are found in your food store.

After mating, the half-inch female moth can lay as many as 400 eggs at one time. The eggs hatch into a (pupa), from which emerge new moths. The moth's life cycle lasts from 2 to 4 weeks.

#### ARE PANTRY MOTH?

The good news: This pest doesn't escape your foods and is not a threat to your pets like rodents.

The bad news: Indian meal moths can be dispersed throughout your home.

#### HOW TO CONTROL PANTRY MOTH?

First, get the infested flour out of the house. Put it in the trash, unless you plan to use it. Bury the infested product(s) in a plastic bag. Don't store that trash in the kitchen. Then, remove everything from the pantry and scrub all surfaces. Remove flour from corners and the undersides of shelves. Meal-moth larvae have legs tucked away in door hinges, cracks, and edges of jar lids, cans, and boxes. The larvae can chew through plastic. The larvae bought from bulk storage have a low entry of meal-moth.
