





ASHLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORTS

ASHLAND Ashland Fire Department reports from Sept. 20 through Friday.

Fires/Alarms: Sept. 21: 500 Winchester Ave. for a fire alarm. Crews investigated and found alarm was due to vaping and alarm was reset prior to arrival. Sept. 21: 5031 Williams Ave. for a line down. Crews investigated and found a phone line and removed it from the roadway.

Sept. 22: 2749 Winchester Ave. for a small porch fire. Crews found fire out upon arrival. Used a water extinguisher to cool area. Damages were reported at \$200 and crews were on scene for an hour.

Sept. 22: 827 Rogers Court to investigate an odor. Crews monitored the air and found no hazards apparent.

Sept. 22: 3124 Central Ave. to investigate a smoldering bike and tire on the porch. APD used an extinguisher prior to arrival to knock down fire. AFD crews used a water extinguisher to cool down area. Damages were reported at \$50.

Sept. 22: 3101 Winchester Ave. for a fire alarm. Crews investigated and found burnt food activated alarm in 4th floor apartment, no fire. Reset alarm.

Sept. 22: 461 Riverhill Drive for a fire alarm. Crews investigated and found steam from the kitchen activated alarm.

Sept. 23: 29th and Beech Street for reported fuel in the road. Crews investigated and found a small amount and cleared from the roadway.

Tuesday: 3131 Winchester Ave. for a fire alarm. Crews investi-

gated and found cooking smoke activated alarm in 2nd floor apartment, no fire. Reset alarm.

Wednesday: 3131 Winchester Ave. for a fire alarm. Crews investigated and found no problems. Reset alarm.

Thursday: 4708 Winchester Ave. for a fire alarm. Crews investigated and found no problems. Occupants had reset alarm prior to arrival.

Friday: 500 Winchester Ave. for a fire alarm. Crews investigated and found construction dust activated alarm. Reset alarm.

Motor Vehicle Accidents: Sept. 23: 29th and Carter Avenue for a two-vehicle accident. Assisted EMS crew with checking for injuries and loading of two patients for transport to the hospital. Cleared the roadway of debris and fluids.

Rescue: Sept. 22: Responded to area of 700 block of Gantt Court to assist with searching a mis-

ing person report. Person was later found with family.

Tuesday: 3131 Winchester Ave. for persons stuck in the elevator. Crews gained entry and removed passengers from the first floor.

Cleared the tracks and reset the elevator. EMS Calls: Sept. 23: Robin Lynn Drive to gain entry into residence to assist EMS crew.

Wednesday: Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. for two persons over-

dosed inside a vehicle. Crews were able to gain entry into the vehicle for EMS crews to administer care.

AFD responded to two more reported overdose calls in the city this week.

AFD also responded to 10 other medical calls in the City this week with seven patients being transported by EMS to the hospital and one by the coroner.
