ORDER

On October 14, 2019, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) filed a motion for leave to withdraw its Application for Approval of State Waiver of the Reassessment Interval Required by 49 C.F.R. § 192.939 (Application), which is the subject of this proceeding. As grounds for its motion, LG&E confirmed it had obtained the usable data needed to conduct integrity assessments on all of its pipelines that require them this year. As a result, the requested waiver is not needed.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that LG&E's motion should be granted, and the Application should be withdrawn without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. LG&E's motion is granted.
2. The Application is withdrawn without prejudice.
3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
