Paducah Water Works hereby provides notice that it will file with the Public Service Commission no later than June 1, 2019, to increase its wholesale water rate to West McCracken County Water District effective July 1, 2019.

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing.
