Nonrecurring Sanitary Sewer Charges Tariff Filing – 807 KAR 5:011 §10

Dear Executive Director Pinson,

This is an application to pass through an increase in certain nonrecurring charges – tap-on fees – for the Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District's Sewer Service Tariff. A corresponding increase in Lexington Fayette Urban County Government's ("LFUCG") tap-on fees brought about the need for the District's proposed increases. These charges will apply to all of the District's future sanitary sewer customers.

Enclosed please find: 1) proposed tariff sheets; 2) LFUCG's notice of increase; 3) notice to customers, which the undersigned avers was mailed out to all sewer customers by District staff this same July 15, 2019; and 4) a letter to the Attorney General evidencing electronic transmission of this filing to that office at that office at trateintervention@Ky.gov.

The District has previously filed income statements and balance sheets with the Commission that are currently on file in your office.

My client is not requesting a rate increase at this time. However, increased costs attributable to the subject nonrecurring charges increase cannot be financially absorbed by the District. The additional revenue generated by the proposed nonrecurring charges will not exceed five (5%) percent of the total revenues provided by all nonrecurring charges for the recent twelve month period.

JSEWD is requesting that the statutory notice period be waived, and that it be permitted to immediately begin implementing the new tap-on fees. JSEWD received notice from LFUCG dated June 10th. At this time, the next Board of Commissioners meeting to ratify a pass-through application was July 3rd. Even after that July 3rd meeting and ratification, statutory notice under KRS

§ 278.180 requires JSEWD to apply and wait 30 days before being able to increase its rates, while LFUCG's rates will take effect on July 15th. JSEWD submits that rather than JSEWD independently increasing a rate, this tap-on increase request is more akin to a treated sewage adjustment, which 807 KAR 5:075 permits to be passed through immediately, with subsequent notice only to customers. Thus JSEWD asks that the statutory notice period be waived altogether and that JSEWD not be caused to pay new customers' tap-on fees—by virtue of waiting for Board approval of this application, or, in the alternative, that the notice period be shortened to 20 days (as permitted for cause, pursuant to the same KRS 278.180).
