



Monroe County Water District applied to the Public Service Commission for an adjustment of rates in the total amount of \$2,237,635.43 on an annual basis, which is an increase of \$175,995.33 or approximately 8.5 percent over normalized revenues from water sales of \$2,061,640.10 on August 20, 2019 to be put into effect upon review and approval by Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

The comparison of the present and proposed rates of the Monroe County Water District is as follows:

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed rates, then the monthly bill for residential customer using an average of 4,000 gallons per month will increase from \$40.71 to \$44.18. This is an increase of \$3.47 or 8.5%.

The rates contained in this Notice are the rates proposed by Monroe County Water District however, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged different from the proposed rates contained in this Notice.

Monroe County Water District has available for inspection at its office the application which it submitted to the Public Service Commission. A person may examine this application at Monroe County Water District's office located at 205 Capp Harlan Road, Tompkinsville, KY 42167.

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Monroe County Conservation District 2019 Annual Report

The Monroe County Conservation District is proud to provide financial and technical assistance to the landowners of Monroe County. The Monroe County Conservation District was organized to plan and carry out a program of soil and water conservation on all land within the county. The District receives financial assistance from the Kentucky Division of Conservation and the Monroe County Fiscal Court and is presently operating within its budget. The Monroe County Conservation District remains a member in good standing with both the Kentucky and National Association of Conservation Districts. The Conservation District has representation at the State and National meetings. The county-wide conservation program is administered by seven supervisors at meetings held once a month. The meetings are held the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 1:00 p.m. at our office on 201 W. Paige St., Tompkinsville, KY and are open to the public.

The Monroe County Conservation District is planning to apply for the CAIP program and will hold a meeting to discuss the upcoming program with producers. This program enables a wide variety of practices on a 50/50 cost share basis. These practices include Hay Storage, Fencing, Water Tanks, Handling Facilities, Pasture Renovation, Cattle Genetics and Technology. The money is divided equally amongst all that participate in the program. The CAIP program has brought over \$3.7 million dollars into our county and provided much needed assistance in these areas. We will have an announcement in the newspaper, on our facebook page and by electronic billboard with all the sign-up information and dates.

The Monroe County Conservation District aids producers in state cost share funding for various projects. Feel free to drop by the office for any of your conservation questions or needs. Our staff is available to assist you with conservation needs and aid in sign-up for funding on available programs. State Cost Share and EOIP are continuous sign-ups throughout the year. These programs address your conservation resource concerns and allow funding assistance thru one or more of the programs.

The Conservation District continues to provide landowners with rental equipment such as no-till drills at \$10 an acre and sprayers for \$30 a day. The District also has filter fabric available for sale. The Monroe County Conservation District is continuing to reimburse \$45 for the removal of fatten animals, upon bringing a receipt into the office.

Each year the Conservation District sponsors a scholarship to a graduating senior, who plans to attend college and major in the agriculture field. The 2019 recipient was Austyn Betcher. The Conservation District also promotes the Jim Claypool poster and essay contest. The 1st place county overall winner for her poster was Caylyn Cornwell from JHC Elementary School and Keeton Turner from MCMS won 1st place county overall for his essay. We congratulate them both on a fine job. The 2019 contest will start again in October. We encourage all students to participate.

Lydia Smith is the District Conservationist for Monroe County. She filed the vacant position in February and works to provide technical and financial assistance for Monroe County through various programs. The local NRCS and Monroe County Conservation District work together in getting approval for Environmental Quality Incentives Program in Monroe County. NRCS and the Conservation District along with Kentucky Dept. of Fish and Wildlife, Kentucky Division of Forestry and the Farm Service Agency work together to provide the technical assistance through the following programs: Environmental Quality Incentive Program, Conservation Stewardship Program, Conservation Reserve Program, Grassland Reserve Program and Wetland Reserve Programs. Feel free to come by or call our office to see what programs are available to address your environmental concerns.

Monroe County Water District applied to the Public Service Commission for an adjustment of rates in the total amount of \$2,237,635.43 on an annual basis, which is an increase of \$175,995.33 or approximately 8.5 percent over normalized revenues from water sales of \$2,061,640.10 on August 20, 2019 to be put into effect upon review and approval by Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

The comparison of the present and proposed rates of the Monroe County Water District is as follows:

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed rates, then the monthly bill for residential customer using an average of 4,000 gallons per month will increase from \$40.71 to \$44.18. This is an increase of \$3.47 or 8.5%.

The rates contained in this Notice are the rates proposed by Monroe County Water District however, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged different from the proposed rates contained in this Notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may submit a timely written request to intervene to the Public Service Commission at the address shown below establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication of this notice, the Commission may take final action on the application. Despite being just a few hours away from uploading to our printer we were able to submit the corrected version into our publication for August 29, 2019.
