Dear Ms. Pinson:

The Monroe County Water District (MCWD) is in receipt of the PSC Staff Report for the application of an alternative rate adjustment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076 required by the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority in the above-referenced case. We sincerely appreciate your staff's assistance through the process, review and recommendations. The PSC staff have calculated and recommend a rate increase of 30.55%. The District's auditor and engineer had prepared the District's Commissioners for an increase of $\sim 7\%$ and through the application process, we determined an increase of 8.54%. However, we concur and accept PSC staff's findings of known and measurable changes to test-year operations and adjustments and comprehend our discrepancies they addressed. MCWD is not challenging the 30.55% determination therefore, we are not requesting a hearing.

MCWD Commissioners and staff are however concerned and believe the 30.55% increase would place a significant hardship on the customers and herein request the Commission's consideration of a phase-in approach increase to rates. All customer rates were raised in 2017 by 7.06% and the wholesale rates were raised to \$4.15/1000 gallons by our wholesale water provider. A phase-in approach would provide us ample time to complete a cost of service study based upon a full year of operations producing our own water to appropriately set a new wholesale rate. The MCWD Commissioners are herein requesting a 10.55% Year-1 increase and ten percent per annum thereafter with full implementation by March 2022. The District would greatly appreciate your consideration of the phased-in approach.

With a two-cycle customer billing, timing of meter readings, and the complexity of the billing software, the District staff is requesting PSC's further consideration of the increases be effective

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and implemented on the first date of a month (i.e. Mar 1, Apr 1). Thank you for your consideration of our requests. Please contact the District should you require any additional information.
