Excavation Damage: Failure to use hand tools where required

Description of Incident During a sewer drain installation, the contractor hit a 1" PE service line going to one customer.

Summary Information 4/26/2019

During excavation for a ongoing job alongside this roadway, the contractor broke a 1" PE service line leading to one customer. When the field technician arrived, the pipe was bent over and he proceeded to squeeze it off. The construction crew arrived and did the repair, pressure tested the line and restored service to the customer. The contractor then broke the same line while backfilling the ditch. KFG field technician was in the area and squeezed it off within 10 minutes of the call. KFG construction crew repaired the line, did a pressure test, then restored gas to the customer.

Full details such as the cause Both hits resulted in a complete break of the line, gas loss was minimal

Extent of the damage \$600.00

Cost of the damage KFG technicians remained in the area until the job was done and requested communication when the contractor would be doing any continuing area of work near the gas lines.
