A couple years ago, we were "required" to join into the GCSSD via a \$1000 fee and the cost of a plumber to connect.. My septic system worked fine and had been well maintained. The additional cost of sewer was a burden. Now, after being "required" to pay a fee, have a major increase monthly by adding an additional "sewer" charge each month they want to drastically increase our rates? I get approximately a 2% raise a year. This is a ridiculous and unnecessary burden to the residents.
