ORDER


On December 27, 2019, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) filed a motion requesting that an informal conference (IC) be scheduled for the purpose of discussing the case in person to “help to further an understanding of any issues.”¹ LG&E did not request a timeframe for when the IC should be held.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that LG&E has not established good cause to schedule an informal conference before discovery has been issued in this case. The Commission finds that the IC should be denied. LG&E may renew its motion after discovery has taken place or should the Commission determine that an IC is necessary, after discovery has taken place, the Commission will schedule the IC at its discretion.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that LG&E’s motion for an informal conference is denied.
