ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on February 11, 2020, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) for the six months that ended on October 31, 2019. As part of this review, KU responded to two requests for information.


A review of KU's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$0.01933 per kWh in October 2019 to a high of \$0.02372 per kWh in May 2019 with a six-month average of \$0.02227 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of KU's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits billed by KU through its FAC from May 1, 2019, through October 31, 2019, are approved.
2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
