ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on February 11, 2020, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) for the six months that ended on October 31, 2019. As part of this review, Duke Kentucky responded to two requests for information.

A review of Duke Kentucky's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$0.020429 per kWh in June 2019 to a high of \$0.037271 per kWh in October 2019 with a six-month average of \$0.026418 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of Duke Kentucky's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
