ORDER

On March 2, 2020, Martin Gas, Inc. (Martin) filed its proposed Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) rate report to be effective April 1, 2020. After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Martin's report includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.
2. Martin's report sets out an Expected Gas Cost (EGC) of \$5.1223 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.1055 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$5.2278 per Mcf.
3. Martin's report sets out no supplier Refund Adjustment.
4. Martin's report sets out a current quarter Actual Adjustment (AA) of (\$.0316) per Mcf. Martin's total AA is (\$.1046) per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.0069 per Mcf from its previous total AA of (\$.1115) per Mcf.
5. Martin's report sets out no Balance Adjustment.
6. Martin's report sets out a GCR rate of \$5.0177 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.0986 per Mcf from the previous GCR rate of \$5.1163 per Mcf.
7. The rates set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for service rendered by Martin on and after April 1, 2020.

8. Should Martin purchase sustainable natural gas from a renewable source during the reporting period of any future GCR reports, then the supplier, cost, and amount must be documented in its cover letter to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Martin and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for service rendered on and after April 1, 2020.

2. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Martin shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.

3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
