State the nature of your concern: Last week I mailed a letter of concern to your office about how the billing and new proposed increase rate could possibly effect low-income individuals. I composed the letter late at night, and didn't realize until AFTER I mailed it, that my numbers were completely wrong! You would not think that I am an educator! Instead of \$1.00 a gallon, I should have said, \$.01 per gallon. Currently, residents pay a minimum bill of \$20.24 for UP TO 2,000 gallons of water. I propose that if a resident uses LESS THAN the minimum amount, they be charged by the gallon. If an individual uses only 1500 gallons, then they should be charged around \$15.00. I have no concern for anything OVER 2,000 gallons.
