ORDER

On May 24, 2021, in a final Order the Commission conditionally granted AEUG Fleming’s application for a Certificate to Construct an approximately 188-megawatt alternating current (MWac) merchant solar electric generating facility in Fleming County, Kentucky. AEUG Fleming’s Certificate to Construct the facility was subject to full compliance with the mitigation measures and condition prescribed in Appendix A of the final Order. Mitigation measure No. 13 in Appendix A states:

Regarding AEUG Fleming’s commitment to submit a glare study that will confirm that there will be no red glare at key observation points, the Siting Board notes that such a study will not be filed until June 15, 2021, which is approximately three weeks after the issuance of this final order. Because the Siting Board will not have an opportunity to review the glare study prior to making its decision in this case, the final decision reached in this Order will be conditioned upon the Siting Board’s review and approval of the glare study once it is submitted.

Accordingly, the ultimate decision reached in the May 24, 2021 final Order will be conditioned upon the Siting Board's review and approval of the glare study once it is submitted.


On June 15, 2021, AEUG Fleming filed the glare study with the Commission. The result of the study indicates no visible glare will be created by the AEUG Fleming solar facility. The Siting Board approves the glare study as filed. The condition detailed in mitigation measure No. 13 of Appendix A of the May 24, 2021 final Order is thus satisfied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. AEUG Fleming's application for a Certificate to Construct an approximately 188 MWac merchant solar electric generating facility in Fleming County, Kentucky, remains conditionally granted subject to full compliance with the mitigation measures and conditions prescribed in Appendix A of the May 24, 2021 final Order.

2. The Siting Board approves the glare study submitted by AEUG Fleming as filed, satisfying the condition provided in mitigation measure No. 13 listed in Appendix A of the May 24, 2021 final Order.
