WHEREAS, broadband is an essential need for community vitality, including competitive economic development, affordable and quality health care, equitable education and effective government; and

WHEREAS, vast areas of Crittenden County lack access to affordable and reliable high-speed broadband services that meet or exceed the federal broadband standards; and

WHEREAS, the recent COVID-19 pandemic has put a spotlight on the need for broadband access in rural areas throughout our Commonwealth and as Kentuckians complied with shelter in place guidelines, the need for broadband for work, school, doctor appointments, and other essential communications has been amplified; and

WHEREAS, Kenergy Corporation is a nonprofit electric cooperative engaged in the business of distributing retail electric power to member consumers in Crittenden and surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, Kenergy Corporation desires to provide broadband access to its members; however, KRS 278.2201 and KRS 278.2213 prohibits Public Service Commission (PSC) regulated electric providers from subsidizing non-regulated activities such as broadband development; and

WHEREAS, Kenergy Corporation has requested a waiver of KRS 278.2201 and KRS 278.2213 from the Kentucky PSC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Crittenden County Fiscal Court supports the development of broadband infrastructure throughout the Kenergy Corporation service area.
- The Crittenden County Fiscal Court supports Kenergy Corporation's request for a waiver from Kentucky PSC, allowing them to engage in the development and financing of broadband activities that will provide much needed access to high speed broadband throughout their service region.
