We received a notice of a proposal rate increase in our residential sewer rate for Persimmon Ridge Subdivision. Our current rate is \$35.00 per month. The proposal rate is \$96.14 per month, an increase of over 174% - **Outrageous!**

We understand that cost may increase annually for capital improvements, but an increase of this magnitude is totally unacceptable. Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company, Ltd. (Bluegrass Water) took over as our provider on September 30th, 2019. Bluegrass Water stated in its purchase application that the rates for each utility initially will remain unchanged, but that it will eventually apply to the PSC for a unified rate for all their systems. Any variance in rate will have to be approved by the PSC.

We ask that the PSC deny this massive rate increase for all services areas as being excessive.
