RESOLUTION NO. 20- 21

A RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO GRANT
ONLY THE MINIMUM RATE INCREASE WARRANTED

WHEREAS, Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company, LLC (Bluegrass") has applied for the authority to adjust water and sewage rates with respect to the homeowners located in the Homestead Subdivision, Longview Estates, Moon Lake Estates, and Triport Road area (I-75 & Delaplain Road interchange area) located in Scott County; and

WHEREAS, if fully granted, said adjustment would increase the fees to these neighborhoods up to six hundred percent (600%); and

WHEREAS, an increase of this magnitude would place an unnecessary financial burden on the homeowners in these neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Scott County Fiscal Court desires to express their concern to the Public Service Commission that any increase granted be the minimum necessary amount only;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Scott County Fiscal Court as follows:

The Scott County Fiscal Court hereby strongly encourages the Public Service Commission to only grant the minimum increase justified to Bluegrass with respect to Case No. 2020-00290 in order to protect the citizens of Scott County from an unwarranted financial hardship.
